### Instructions:

3. The students can participate for the event individually or in pairs (in group of maximum 2 students).
4. Each student or group will have to represent and prepare for only one country. And, same country can't be opted by more than 1 individuals/groups. The selection of the country is on the first come first serve basis.
5. The event will be conducted in English language only.
6. The event will be conducted under the supervision of incharge teacher and the 2 students appointed has the volunteers from grade XII.
