Instructions:

- 1. The interested students will have to give their names to the event in-charge Mr. Niraj Gupta/Mr. Aneshwar Nishad before or by 16/11/2022.
- 2. There should be a groups consisting of 5 students in a single group. The student's responsibility:
 - 2 Students for selling
 - 1 for helping
 - 2 for making customers / marketing

Note: In every group 1 parent is allowed. Means in a group there will be 5 students and 1 parent. Total 6 members in a group are allowed

- 3. The students will be given place 1 day prior to set-up their stalls. The students will set- up stall themselves.
 - For e.g. Arrangement of table, decoration of their stall, any carpentry work if needed. The students will have to pay Rs. 100/- to school as a rent.
- 4. Every group will have to register their food items by 17/11/2022 and should confirm it with the event in-charge. Every stall will have different food items. Repetition of the food items will not be allowed. The students are not supposed to purchase the foods from the market readymade and sell on their stalls. Bread, butter, cheese etc. will be allowed, there should be no use of gas/stove for the food / dish prepared, so select your food / dish accordingly.
- 5. The students will have to prepare their food items at home and then bring to the school. The students will contribute the material among themselves equally as required.
- 6. The students will have to take their remaining food item or material left at home and will not leave in school premises. If any loss / damage occurred with a student / stall the school has no responsibility under any circumstances.
- 7. Every group will keep the rate of their foods / dish in multiple of 10. For e.g. Rs.10/- , Rs.20/- , Rs. 30/- etc.
- 8. The students will purchase the coupons from the counter in multiple of Rs.10/- stall member will collect the coupons and sell their food item. The students will not be allowed to purchase the food item directly on the stall by paying cash.

- 9. At the end, each stall group will submit the coupons on the counter and will collect their amount. Every group will pay Rs. 50/- to the school as a coupon printing charges.
- 10. The best 3 groups that will earn the highest profit will be awarded with the certificates.
- 11. Students will have to write down their expenditure and submit in the office.

- 12. The event in-charge will collect the names of the stall head and take their sign and submit in the office.
- 13. The students of all classes are allowed to purchase the food items from the stalls toencourage the participants.
