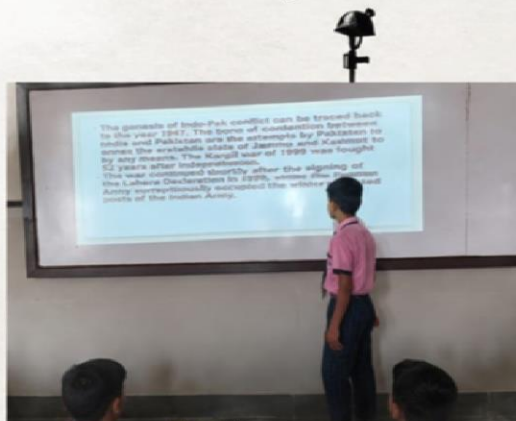
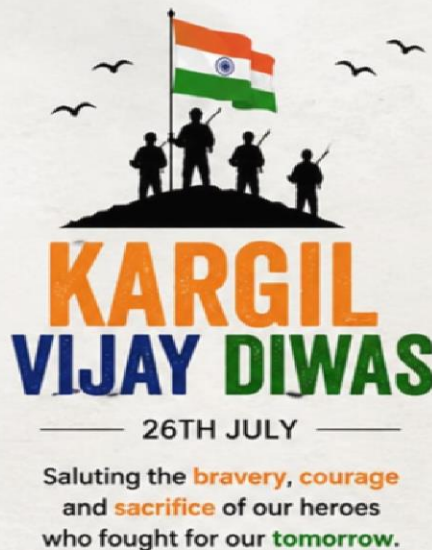

- The genesis of Indo-Pak conflict can be traced back to the year 1947. The bone of contention between India and Pakistan are the attempts by Pakistan to annex the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir by any means. The Kargil war of 1999 was fought 52 years after the independence of India.
- The war commenced shortly after the signing of the Lahore declaration in 1999, when the Pakistan Army surreptitiously occupied the winter vacated posts of the Indian Army.

INTRODUCTION

Kargil Vijay Diwas is celebrated every year on 26 of July in India, to commemorate India's victory over Pakistan in the Kargil War of 1999. The conflict began from the Indian Army's efforts to remove Pakistani forces from the Kargil district in Jammu and Kashmir. The Pakistani army had occupied the area in May 1999. The war was fought in the hills of Kargil district. The war was fought in extremely cold weather at an altitude of 15,000 feet.

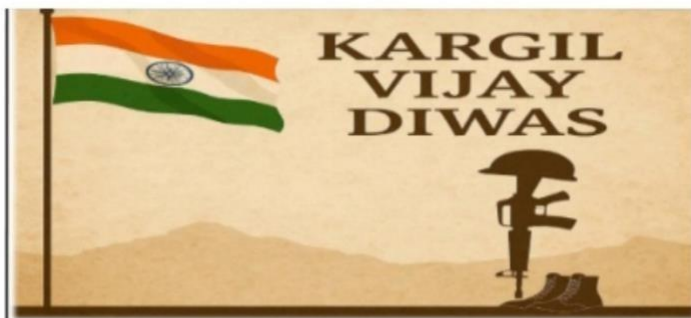

Key Events of the War

- War began in May 1999 when Indian patrols discovered infiltrators.
- High-altitude warfare at 18,000 feet.
- Operation Vijay launched by India to flush out intruders.
- War ended on 26th July 1999 with India regaining control.

- Pakistan's Operation Badr aimed to infiltrate Indian positions in Kargil.
- Violation of the peaceful Lahore Declaration signed in 1999.
- Intended to cut India's access to Siachen Glacier and Ladakh.
- Assumption that nuclear deterrence would prevent Indian retaliation.

- India launched Operation Vijay and recaptured all occupied positions.
- Loss of over 500 Indian soldiers who displayed

Contribution of Our Brave Heroes

- Captain Vikram Batra (PVC) – "Yeh Dil Maange More!" – captured Point 4875 (led from the front.)
- Grenadier Yogendra Singh Yadav (PVC) – climbed vertical cliff under fire.
- Rifleman Sanjay Kumar (PVC) – fought alone to neutralize enemy bunkers.
- Major Rajesh Singh Adhikari, Captain Anuj Nayyar, and many others showed exemplary courage.
- 527 Indian soldiers sacrificed their lives for the nation.
- Countless others gave their all to defend the nation.
